Last August, in a lecture on basic processing, Ron Hubbard said, "An introvert, a person with an inferiority complex, will attain and maintain altitude by asserting that what he knows is much too complicated, too academic for the ordinary person to learn, and will try to discourage any attempt to learn, and will hide the knowledge as deeply as possible."

I don't want to be like that. I've stumbled onto something, and I want to give it to you in as simple and understandable form as possible.

An internal; self-determined set of dynamics has not, to my knowledge, yet been postulated. Could this be an explanation of what Ron Howes, the Minneapolis Clear, meant when he said "I made my world different. I changed it."? Can we postulate a self-contained universe, entirely self-determined with our skin as its boundary? If we can do this, and "make our world different" by rehabilitating our own

self-determinism along all of our internal dynamics, we can easily and swiftly become "clears."

Could it be that the internal dynamics begin with ourselves as Dynamic 8, the God of our Universe? Can we establish an internal set of dynamics which will parallel the external set? I think so. Let's try it.

Let's begin with 1 = 8, with Ourselves as Gods of our own, personal Universes. We, in ourselves, contain all of the dynamics and can do with them as we will. We can enforce, inhibit, dominate, nullify, or allow self-determinism to any internal dynamic. All of our physical and/or mental aberrations are truly self-determined.

Dynamic 7, our own personal Theta, can by sympathy or compartism with any other dynamic, external or internal, cause a change in other internal dynamics.

Dynamic 6, our own personal MEST, in conjunction with our own personal Theta (Dynamic 7), constitutes our:

Dynamic 5, Personal Lambda, or Life. Here we begin to find the cause of psychosomatic illnesses. When we have tried to influence one of the other dynamics, and have failed in the attempt to enforce, inhibit or change motion or A R C of that dynamic,

we go through the cycle of regret and blame, and eventually assign the blame and penance to the particular internal dynamic concerned.

Dynamic 4, Personal Integrity maybe compared to the executive branch of government, if we consider Dynamic 7 the legislative, and Dynamic 6 the judicial branch. Personal Integrity having been invalidated by the failure of the organism to influence an outer dynamic or dynamics, proceeds to dole out penance to the internal dynamic which has been "found guilty."

Dynamic 3, Personal "groups" or "systems," are the first to get word "that they, or a member of their group, has failed, and must pay the penalty. The personal groups include the muscular, nervous, glandular, respiratory, digestive, circulatory, reproductive, articulatory, lymphatic, excretory, etc. etc. In line with this theory, it would be logical to assume that the epicenter, or sub-center controlling the particular group concerned would be the first point of contact with Personal Integrity, or Dynamic 5. Then, passing the buck on down the line to the individual "family" (muscle, joint, nerve, gland, etc.) of which many individual cells are members, Dynamic 2 would be, of course, that family, and when the primitive order was received, the family would see to it that the pro-survival activities of the particular cell or cells concerned were cut down to the extent demanded by the primitive order. Dynamic 1, the individual cell, being thus inhibited, would go down in tone, would deteriorate, causing other cells in the "family" to deteriorate, etc. etc., right up to the top of the heap again.

And all of this is brought about by "belief without understanding." Because we fail to achieve A R C with an outer dynamic, we arbitrarily shut off A R C with an inner dy-

Of course, there are other reasons for psychosomatic illness. How about Aunt Emma, whose death we "caused" by not being more in A R C with her? We "regret" her death, we "blame" ourselves, and as penance, we duplicate her "goals" (arthritis, gallstones, excess weight), thus carrying out a life continuum for dear old Aunt Emma.

How about "belief without understanding" that we may have experienced when a friend,

relative, doctor or psychoanalyst has said, "The trouble with you is-"?

How about "belief without understanding, "that time we got hit by a Mack truck, or were born, or were hung (in a past life)? How about all the other times when we were "wrong", and "failed."?

May I suggest that we review our lives, past and present, and "forgive" ourselves for the many failures we have experienced, failures to influence any other dynamic, and carry the forgiveness thru to the farthest extent of our first internal dynamic. If we can do this, and I'm sure we can, we will find that to forgive is truly divine.

I fully realize that, if this concept is new, it is only the beginning, and that

many people will try to make it complicated when it is really very simple.

You could sum it up like this. We are, all of us, walking monuments to our failures,

and, up until recently, we've been too damned stubborn to forgive ourselves.

Almost any therapy could clear us, if we could first establish internal A R C, and it seems to me that the best way to do that is thru internal communication, which dates back many thousands of years, and was last September codified and called Effort Processing by L. Ron Hubbard.

AS ABOVE, SO BELOW By Morgan J. Morey

Now more than ever before it can be said that if an auditor fails to bring a preclear up the tone scale rapidly and efficiently, it is because that auditor does not know the processes, not the processes themselves. Hubbard's SYMBOLOGICAL PROCESSING provides an excellent approach to the psychotic, neurotic, or other low-tone cases. Technique 80 can, I believe, in many cases resolve a neurosis or psychosis in a few hours. With the understanding of overt acts and motivators that it provides. we can see that in many cases the running of the service facsimile itself is not going to play as much of a role in obtaining a release as will the running of the overt act or acts that made it necessary to

have a service facsimile (justifier). This, of course, verifies Max Freedom Long's strong emphasis all the time on what he more conventionally called a guilt complex. Except that $M_{\bullet}F_{\bullet}L_{\bullet}$ didn't know how to get rid of the complex by running out the regret on the overt act.

The use of the Electropsychometer, as I see it, is almost a necessity if the auditor is to do a fast job. I would like to emphasize, however, that in the opinion of myself and others, it is not desirable to confuse the Electropsychometer reading with the general tone-scale concept. As Hubbard says in his paper on Electropsychometric auditing, this instrument measures body density (or resistance) and this, I would regard as only one aspect of tone. For somantic reasons, I wonder if it would not have been a good idea to have used some other type of scale on the instrument in order to prevent identification of these two different measurements. Incidentally, there is another very good auditing instrument on the market, known as the B & W Electronic Psychometer, which uses a decile measurement scale. It does not, however, have nearly the sensitivity of the Matheson instrument.

I would also like to point out that, in my opinion, it is not possible to determine from the instrument whether or not an incident being run by the preclear is valid or "dubbed-in". A symbolic incident, the internal structure of which is similar to the computations of the preclear's case, will produce reactions similar to an actual incident. Thus, psychometric evidence cannot be used to "prove" the validity of pre-lives, facsimile 1, "glare-fights" or any other such incidents. These still must be accepted on the basis of subjective reality, and no other basis, except that, perhaps, of computation. The fact that the proper running of such incidents produces observable changes in the preclear's behaviour patterns must, at the present, be accepted as sufficient reason for running these incidents.

For quite some time, I have felt that perhaps the important thing in processing was not "what is run" but "how it was processed." The things we do each day portray completely, in present time, the signs of every decision we have ever made. The incident of yesterday, that is in relatively full recall, if properly audited, might produce more desirable change in behaviour than the auditing of an incident of 50 trillion years ago. Therefore, while Hubbard and others have been exploring the content of the different tracks, I have concentrated on the content of present time. This has been remarkably productive, leading to the discovery of at least two perceptics possessed by most people, but not often used, that produce some very interesting effects when applied to the handling of a facsimile during an audit session. A technique for getting at highly occluded computations by using a special path designed, it seems, almost especially for that purpose, has also been worked out. The use of this extra communication channel by the preclear seems to me more desirable than the forcing of the material by instrument detection. For you readers who would like to work this technique out for yourselves, I will provide a hint in the old axiom "As above so below." For others, the technique is treated in full in our publication "EXTRA DIMENSIONAL AWARENESS."

With this technique and other tools, where their use was indicated, we have been getting some very good results. Auditors who know these tools, and the applications, certainly can have every reason for feeling confident about what they can do.

THE BASIS OF ABERATION - By Florence F. Mitchell

Much has been said and written about the basis of aberation - what aberation really is. "It is the illusion man accepts in order not to be alone." "Aberation stems from the desire not to be alone." Before any of us will know what aberation is, it is necessary to achieve our own insight on what might be called the "opposite deep truths" (they are actually apposite) of aloneness and togetherness. (Togetherness is oneness with others - oneness with universe - oneness with everything on all dynamics.)

From what I have read and heard of the so-called schism in Dianetics, it appears to

me that the question is being approached with an Aristotlian-either-or-type of logic. 'One must be either alone or together, but one cannot be both." The state of Clear is the ability to act freely and optimumly upon both at the same time. Both are necessary. Aloneness seems to be necessary in order to maintain communication with self. It need not be physical aloneness. It is simply the direction of attention to self. For a Clear this may be necessary only on a physical awareness level. Do not confuse this with Self-Determinism. It is not the same thing at all. Togetherness is also necessary. On how many dynamics can you have any survival if you are alone? The DESIRE not to be alone is good survival. The desire to have oneness - complete oneness - with all beings is optimum, but it seems it cannot be done until one has achieved complete, continuous and automatic communication with ones Theta -- all of one's Theta -- right up to the limit of endowment. I believe this may be the state of Theta Clear. It is certainly beyond the state of Mest Clear as orginally presented. Complete communication with one's self is the aloneness side of the question. Complete communication with, or oneness with, others is the togetherness side of the question. Complete communication with others includes a telepathic mode of communication, a part of which Dr. Coulter has described as "semantic telepathy". Complete communication with MEST would include, it seems, something that has been described as 'telekenisis'. 'Levitation' and 'teleportation' seem to be outputs of the same energy, and might be included in communication with MEST.

optimum survival on all dynamics is complete communication — oneness — being a part of everything on all dynamics. Basically, this is love. There is nothing mystic about love. It is simply being a part of everything and having everything a part of you. This is most easily demonstrated on the 8th dynamic because we don't get 'backtalk' from God. If you are a part of God and He a part of you and both of you a part of the same thing; YOU LOVE GOD, and the sentence "God is love" has a very real meaning. This follows on all dynamics, and reality (*) on this is particularly important to marriage. If you and your mate have achieved reality on this you KNOW that you love mutually. You don't have to ask 'do you love me' or 'do I love you'. YOU KNOW. The love of husband and wife is the same thing as love of everyone and everything. The only difference is in intensity and scope. Imagine love as a pyramid. At the apex we have small scope and great intensity; at the base we have broad scope and low intensity. Each degree of scope and intensity is real. Low intensity is no less real, enjoyable or necessary to optimum survival than high intensity. We can act freely on all the degrees of love at the same time without occluding any others.

It is true that we choose aberation. When we choose EITHER aloneness or togetherness -- when we choose BETWEEN them -- we choose aberation. Either one alone is not good sur-I believe we make this choice at the first moment that we realize the society in which we have chosen TO BE is not the optimum society we have postulated it would be. This realization and decision might be either before or after conception. It is our first down emotional curve and it's a dilly! It may be the knowledge that mother has occluded her telepathic ability to communicate with us and know immediately when we have arrived. (You should know the minute you become pregnant; not several weeks or months after.) It could be anything that is done around us or to us. The moment we first recognize this aberation we postulate that perhaps everyone in the world is also aberated. With each succeeding aberation we recognize, we strengthen this postulate and finally begin to wonder just how much oneness with the world we can achieve. After all, if communication has been weakened, reality and affinity also have. How much oneness can we have in such a condition? B ut we do want to achieve togetherness with the world if we are going to have survival on all dynamics. How many children can you have all by yourself? Complete aloneness is not a good choice. But how can we have togetherness unless we can communicate? How can we communicate unless we agree or pretend to agree to the aberated 'truth' of the people around us? We can't contact them on any other basis than their 'truth'. What we really want is to act freely upon both togetherness and aloneness at the same time. This is optimum.

(*) Reality is opinion plus instinct. It is a state of knowing that includes the logical thought process of evaluating data and experience, from which opinion is derived; plus that instinct that is apart from reasoning.

Basically, aberation is caused by switching back and forth between aloneness and togetherness. We try to maintain the necessary aloneness and keep in contact with self and 'prime knowledge', but we also choose to agree to others' aberation so we can keep in contact with them. Each time we accept aberation we occlude some of our 'prime knowledge'. Each time we occlude 'knowledge' it becomes easier and more necessary to accept aberation. This can be described as going out into the world and failing, and retreating to evaluate the experience gained, so that we may use it another time, since 'prime knowledge' is not acceptable in an aberated society.

After we make the decision it is then necessary to choose some form of action which will make it easier for us to accept aberation and at the same time keep some measure of contact with self. This form of action is control. We use control when we are presented with a non-survival situation. A nonsurvival situation could mean death. We don't want to accept that much aberation. But since any situation which is not absolute optimum is somewhat non-survival, we use some form and degree of control far more often than we realize. These are the 'things we do to others'. What is control? Isn't it basically anything that denies self-determined insight in another? How many times do you use control in a day?

The state of clearis the ability to use optimumly and act freely upon both deep truths of aloneness and togetherness at the same time without accepting aberation or occluding knowledge. It is complete, automatic, and continuous communication with self and with everything on all dynamics.

Is there anything in this to which you are reacting? What is reaction? When you react to something, there is a truth in it which you have agreed to occlude in yourself. Reaction is your attempt to hold your occluding postulate as truth. Are you reacting? I hope so.

NOTES -- Is it true that aloneness (contact with self) would produce a wide open case, and togetherness (little or no contact with self) would produce an occluded case? Actually it is impossible to choose complete aloneness. How could you depend on mother for food? Probably anyone who does not want to agree to aberation chooses aloneness plus PRETENDED agreement.

Credit for my insight as stated here goes to many dianetic sources who will probably recognize their words. I also gained a great deal from my auditor, Mrs. Helena Ackley, who shares this insight.

MORE OF SRI AUROBINDO - By Richard W. Lundberg

Here is another article on the Sri Aurobindo teachings. This one deals with the duality of the knowledge and the ignorance. "Two are joined together, Powers of Truth, Powers of Maya-they have built the child and given him birth and they nourish his growth." Rig Veda x. 5. 3.

"Maya" is a Sanskrit term meaning illusion, and by extension, the creator of illusion. There are some schools of thought, which hold that all life is Maya; since the only reality is the incommunicable One Existence (Atman, Adwaita). For Dianetic purposes I shall consider the various states of mind to be also real, and deal with one in particular. The dream.

The dream is the most important tool of therapy for June. He uses a technique termed "amplification" best described in Jolan Jacobi's "The Psychology of Jung." Jung himself writes that this book is the only synthesis of Jungian psychology ever written. The arrangement of dreams is radial, around a central significance. The interpretation of the series is like reading an unknown text. It appears that supermind presents know ledge of the more troublesome engrams in very vivid dreams, which correspond to the "attitude" of the pre-clear and are nearly always symbolic, and are compensatory to the

conscious state. Indeed, one could say that mind is struggling to rise from matter while supermind descends from Atman. Illumination, the flash of insight following the dreams discussed, is the rending of the veil between them. The auditor and pre-clear together synthesize a new reaction combining the contents of both conscious and unconscious. Both must contribute to this but only the pre-clear determines the interpretation of the material he brings. Obviously the personality of the auditor, its worth and strength and ethical value, is of the greatest importance. The auditor can bring the p.c. only to the point he himself has gained.

This appears to be more limited than the Dianetic viewpoint, but I somehow feel the Dianetic movement to be somewhat sterile. We hear a great deal about Mest Clears,

but few valuable insights from those same Mest Clears!

We ran across an interesting and quite common affinity break. The nursing infant cuts his teeth and bites mama. She slaps him and refuses to allow him to finish his dinner. Here is a threat to survival - potential starvation, extreme rejection by mama, phrases like, "You little cannibal!" shock, and fright. My phrase was "Bite a steak out of me, will you. Sit there till you decide to be good."

That, of course, is an impossibility as there is no such thing as "good." "Good" is the aberration that there is a split in life. Some things are "good" and some are "evil." It appears that people generally call their own narrow view "good", and anything

outside of it "evil."

An example is the technique known as lock scanning. Jack Naylor presented an original formulation that was and is highly valuable. Hubbard, a somewhat emotional neurotic to say the least, judging by the material hisoffice flooded the country with a few months back, first rejected this material in toto, then watered it down, and finally claimed the emasculated portion forhis own.

I find it difficult to accept the premises set forth in regard to the Hubbard chart of Evaluation. By his chart, I place Hubbard in the 1.1 band! I got around this by finally realizing that the tone scale is a communication scale, the judgement of the auditor being based chiefly on engramic prejudices.

IN REGARDS - By Charles Wallach

IN RE NEW TECHNIQUES: Strictly my own opinion, but I feel that my recent period of bustling about the nation has given me a better than average picture of the American dianetic public. On this basis, I uncork the following sentiments:

There appears to be a move afoot to rush into print with little patchworks of procedure that can be pasted together and called a "technique". This is not intended as an oblique slap at any person, as I am certainly in no position to judge the techniques of another. But even if they are all good, there are too many of them. Many worthy people are building themselves one reality break after another by trying to produce miracles with second-hand interpretations of untried procedures.

They would be better off by far, in most cases, to settle down with a mediocre technique and work it into a practical tool of their own.

In talking to so many people who were disturbed because dianetics had failed to produce the results they once wishfully anticipated, I have been forcefully reminded of the necromancer of renaissance folk-lore. He forged himself an iron collar, and travelled around his little world looking for the touchstone that would turn it to gold. For years he spent his time picking up stone after stone and touching it to his collar. One day he discovered that his iron collar had indeed turned to gold; somewhere in his travels he had found the touchstone -- and threw it down again without knowing it.

Some time ago I heard Hubbard himeslf say, with some amusement, that he was turning out new techniques faster than the boys (at the foundation) could keep up with them. Imagine the feelings of a man in the hinterland who, after being fired with enthusiasm and purpose by Hubbard's first book, is given a list of:

- a. the data he learned that were false -- "we used to think this worked fine, but don't do it any more because it will bog down the case or result in a psychotic break."
- b. superceded data -- "That may work, if you want to waste time with it, but there's another technique that works much better and in one tenth of the time."
- c. promissory data -- "We've got something that's brand new and so hot it will knock your hat off! Makes all the foregoing look ridiculous, but we can't give it to you yet because we haven't got it guite worked out yet."
- it to you yet because we haven't got it quite worked out yet."

 d. The TRUE WORD department may deserve honorary mention; "EUREKA!! At last you too can be a superman. Send us two months salary or so, break away from your family and job for six weeks or so, and we will teach you THE secrets, hot off the designer's griddle. Room & board extra, etc. etc."

This may sound a bit too caustic -- and I guess it must be so, as no mention is made of the many fine, sensible people from Canada to Florida, who are trying to do it the right way.

But perhaps the exaggeration will serve to show how our poor lad in the hinterland gets so thoroughly enturbulated that he begins to think, "Maybe my sneering friends were right in calling diametics a passing fad."

All this turmoil is good for dianetics, but bad for individuals who aren't sufficiently self-determined to keep from being "snowed under".

My examiner, correlator, file clerk, integrator, id, computer and I all agree that some day we shall see a simple and accurate common science of dianetics. I'm all for it, and hope I can help. But just suppose I discover a new technique with which I achieve uniformly good results with two or three of the particular type of people I select for preclears. Would it be helpful if I influenced other kinds of auditors to try my system on other types of preclears, with the expectation of getting my results? I don't think so; and if I had any altitude, it might easily be harmful.

All over the country I've found people so pitifully anxious to be taught to improve themselves in dianetics, that they scarcely bother to evaluate the data they have, or make their own observations. These people need more validation of the fundamental truths, and less multivalent definitions and theorizing. Because they are aberrated? Sure, what did you expect?

Dianetics will never lack adventurous intellects to do the pioneering and experimenting. But it certainly is suffering by losing the active support of adherents who cannot assimilate the gingerbread.

Another thing; authors of new techniques often leave escape hatches by saying, "Of course you must be careful whom you use this on -- some preclears go nuts on interbulate," or "Obviously you have to run out all previous auditing, and be positive you have erased it, before you can expect to get anyplace.

This is about as unprofessional as would be an architect, who having just completed an apartment building, says vaguely "Of course there are several areas in there where you can't put a refrigerator or a pianno, because they'd fall through the floor. I didn't bother to mark them, because they should be obvious."

IN RE NOBILITY: I'm sure you will agree that "WALLACH PRAISES CAMPBELLS! WORK" would be insipid in the extreme, as a headline, even though largely true.

"WALLACH DISAGREES WITH CAMPBELLS" would be equally as unimportant, but a bit more stimulating.

These comments are offered as a puny appology for only whispering their praise, but shouting out this one objection:

Their article on Nobility of Character is too impressive to go unchallenged, because I think it is misleading. If my analysis of this phenomena is correct, then it would be a waste of time to treat it as a separate entity, or dianetic syndrome.

It has been well established that whenever a person performs an irrational act or reaches an illogical conclusion through aberration, the analytical mind immediately tries to whip up a justification to cover the break in normal computational processes. Excuses, reasons, motives appear which must be taken seriously by the preclear, even though they look ridiculous to everyone else.

There is probably no more satisfying motive, than nobility, for an aberree to explain his actions. Example: Papa feeling low; child accidently scuffs table leg with shoe; Papa leaps up and applies belt viciously, because one of his buttons has been pushed. Maybe it's an enforced command, "Quit your kicking," or, "You've got to be careful," or what have you. But when he sets his screaming child down to face the hostility of Mom, he's got to have a good excuse in a hurry. The story usually goes — he had gone to all the trouble of getting up and punishing the child to teach him a lesson; the child must grow up to be considerate of furniture and things, for his own good, etc. etc., as long as Mom will stand there and listen.

There is a troubled character trying to assume the mantle of nobility. Neither Mom nor the child would ever believe that guff, nor would any other observer. But they have learned from experience that the more they argue such a point, the nobler Papa will get until he builds himself up to a point where he can no longer tolerate their ignoble company, and Papa leaves.

And so, if you re-examine this Nobility of Character, I think you will find that it is quite a general term, like "psychosomatic". It describes a secondary manifestation of aberrations, and cannot be pinned down as the direct operation of a specific type of aberration.

I think it's a good idea to have a preclear pick up times when he made a damned fool of himself, as the Campbells suggest. This has often resulted in good material, particularly in effort processing. It may also serve to give the preclear a good picture of how to recognize and avoid such situations.

I enjoyed the brief discussion of masterbation; have always felt that a lot of important sex material is lost by tacit-consent avoidance in many teams. However, the auditor should lead the pre-clear towards such material very carefully, unless affinity is excellent to begin with. Often there are important locks in these murky depths, coexisting with command decisions to "never, never talk about it -- or even think about it."

I've seen two or three pre-clears drift away from their auditors because they felt that their auditors were being "morbid". It requires a sharp lookout to spot the birth of this attitude, and quick action to reduce it. If you don't act quickly, you may have an awful time finding the exact point of the affinity break when the pre-clear doesn't want to even think about it.

One preclear told me, at our first session, that he had a horrible sex secret that he absolutely refused to discuss; and he didn't want me fooling around with it. He mentioned it at every session, and finally I gathered it was something that someone had done to him at age 12, and it was utterly abominable. I racked my brain, and Kraft-Ebing's too, trying to pluck that plum; many an intricate campaign was blasted.

I got it at last -- but only by sheer luck. His brother had touched him on the penis one Sunday morning! The discharge was monumental, and the case opened like a clamshell. If I had been unlucky enough to ask him if anyone had ever touched his penis, he would have gone into a slow burn that I'd play heck reducing.

Better quit before I start talking about my techniques.

Receiving now the "Handbook For Preclears", I feel the necessity to express my doubts concerning the sexual aberration, as analysed in the Handbood, processing act 13, page 67. I have the impression that Hubbard's analysis of sex aberration is not quite "Hubbardian".

When I started to read the first book, "Dianetics," and later the printed literature written by L. R. Hubbard, I was fascinated by its clear analysis of the human mind and aberration. - Now this chapter about sexual aberration is, as it seems to me, a collection of postulates which are, possibly, based upon experiences but are far from proof.

To practise a sexual act for pleasure only and changing the cause into effect, is in my eyes not an aberration. One of the greatest achievements in the history of Mankind is the ability of Man to adapt himself to his environment - and to adapt the environment to the purpose of his survival. This is the main difference between Man and animal. He has

the ability to reach fullest communication with MEST. It is a necessity for Man to live in a reality, in accordance with his environment, at the highest degree of rationality. This is Optimum. If that should be true, how could one accept the postulate cited here-

"In sex one may not desire to be the cause of children. This would be either for man and woman, children in this society, can be embarrassing or expensive. One desires at the same time to cause a sexual partner pleasure. Here is desire not to be a cause fighting with the desire to be a cause. The result is conflict, aberration, impotence,

Sex as punishment and irregular practices.

One can have two children, love his family and be happy - he is strong on DYNAMIC TWO. Then the reality comes in. No room for more children and insufficient income. So he stops having children and practises the sexual act for pleasure. The result need not

be conflict, aberration, impotence, etc.

Any cause has many effects, and sometimes, an uncountable number. The thought is cause. The emotion, effort and result are effects. If one effect is missing because of the demand of reality, theindividual has to decide as a self-determined being, in agreement with determinism of the partner or group. Which way should he choose? He'll choose the most rational! The most rational cannot aberrative.

There is one solution to avoid sexual aberrations, concerning his analysis: to

change a woman into a baby-factory. Is this what we want? I doubt.

As a matter of fact human beings have no period of heat as animals do. Therefore is the sexual act cause-pleasure effect, and the decision to have children another effect. The cause of any sexual aberration lies in this society with its prejudices. Millions of children are brought up with a fear of sex. Parents who wish to avoid that their children should practise a premarital sexual act, often use all their power to suppress the demand of nature. With punishment, beating and threats adults force the youth to suppress this law of nature. This is the cause of sexual aberration. One who was beaten, when he expressed the wish to cohabit - accepts sex as punishment and here we find as a result the sexual aberration with all its variations. A boy who has felt affinity and love from father and brother and was often rejected by mother and other women, may accept this experience for a lifetime. "Women don't love me" - that's the reason for homosexuality. The CAUSE of any aberration is always ENGRAMIC, the aberration is EFFECT.

I'll gladly discuss this matter, and always like to learn from others.

I hope I succeeded to express what I wished to say, because English is not my mother language.

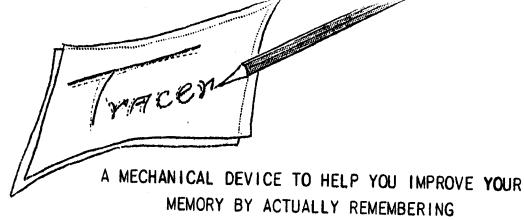
