Processing by an Optimum Now Available!

Many of us have wondered how an optimum individual would act in terms of the third and fourth dynamics, and here is the answer. Dianetists will want to have and use this 2-hour tape of theory, technique, and auditing questions made by Ronald B. Howes. For the first time, an optimum individual has directed his energies toward making his realities and the techniques he has developed in several months of experimentation available to the dianetic field as a whole.

The first side of this tape contains some of Ron's ideas and attitudes with regard to psychotherapy, the goals and purposes of psychotherapy, and an evaluation of the individual in relation to society as a whole. There is also commentary on reality and on the "how" of aberration and de-aberration. This material is presented in such a way as to stimulate thinking and to create an atmosphere conducive to good response to the auditing questions on the second side of the tape.

We have known for several months that Ron was investigating and developing more effective techniques by processing many people many hours each day. Among his goals are those of a heightened tempo of effective processing in the field of dianetics with the aim of building a better society for everyone now and for those to come, and, with the same aim, increased communication of effective techniques. The implementation of these goals includes the present tapes (with others contemplated), the formation of a nation-wide ham radio network devoted to the dissemination of dianetic theory and technique (if you are interested in participating in this, send information as to your equipment and availability to Ronald B. Howes, 1531 East Caramillo, Colorado Springs, Colo.), and contacting various groups and areas of dianetic activity.

In speaking of mental health, Ron says:

Well, for me, mental health would consist in a certain degree of conformity with the cultural pattern of the community. That is to say, our feelings, thought, and acts should exhibit a certain appropriateness....Also, we must possess realizable goals, but they must be constructive ones related to social good.

Three major communications centers in the dianetic field are cooperating to make this material available to you. Gordon Beckstead, of the Psychological Research Foundation, Inc., 616 N. 3rd, Phoenix, Arizona, has made an edited copy of the tape which is suitable for presentation to groups; J. W. Welgos, of the Eidetic Foundation, 252 Merston St., Fairhope, Alabama, has prepared a mimeographed transcript of the Therapeutic Tape and Questionnaires, as well as a transcript of the Fuide's Tape of instructions to auditors as to the use of the therapeutic tape. THE COMMUNICATOR, 53 West Maple Ave., Denver 19, Colorado, is acting as a reproducing and distribution center for the original tape and transcripts. Welgos' trilogy, Simplified Processing, Basic Realities of Processing, and Basic Illusions of Processing, are suggested as companion reading to the tapes. The three volumes present realities and techniques which mesh well with those presented by Ron in the tape.

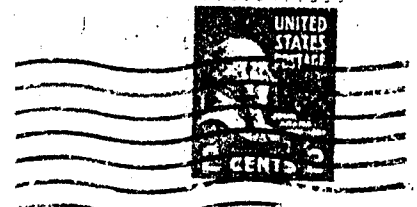

THE COMMUNICATOR is expanding the scope of its publishing activities with a new line of publications: THE COMMUNICATOR Books. These will be larger than the Supplements, and each will feature only one author.

The first of THE COMMUNICATOR Books will be Bitter Pills and a Tonic, by Perry A. Chapdelaine. This book is based on the series of lectures given by Perry in Seattle last fall -- lectures which were outstandingly fine, both in the data presented and in the response of those who heard him.

We shall continue the series with Anthology in Dianese, a collection of the better stories, poems, and parables that have been spread around by and for dianeticists and scientologists. Each story has merit as literature as well as highlighting some aspect of human philosophy or development. Ron Howes, L. Ron Hubbard, Perry Chapdelaine, Fred Boyd, Billi Bowen, and others will be represented.

We shall also edit and publish material from approximately 13 hours of tapes, lectures and auditing sessions, made by Perry in Vancouver this spring. Perry says that these tapes are "teaching, not preaching", and that from them one can gain a good basic understanding of the goals and techniques of psychotherapy.

Now being printed is COMMUNICATOR Supplement No. 4 -- transcripts of two tapes, "A New Orientation on Processing", by Perry, and, "Information for Would-Be Optimims" by Wing Angeli. We are publishing these two tapes together because Perry and Wing presented data which integrates into an extremely valuable whole. In "A New Orientation on Processing" Perry discusses the factors involved in processing the wide open case and the occluded case and tells why it is that dianetic processing has not been more effective in a greater percentage of cases. Wing, in "Information for Would-Be Optimims", gives suggestions for processing and approaches that can and will work for any case.

Many people may feel that THE COMMUNICATOR is overbalancing in the direction of Chapdelaine. Admittedly, we have published more of his material than we have of any other person. There is a very good reason for this: With few exceptions Perry has integrated and made work the data and the goals of psychotherapy more than any other person in the field today. He draws data from his own background and education in psychology, from dianetics, scientology, and many other sources and correlates it into his own synthesis which has been effective without fail when used by persons sincerely desiring to change. Perry's effectiveness is further enhanced by his ability to break enflurence with individuals for the purpose of processing -- to become, in effect, a servo-mechanism which the preclear can use to attain his goals. And, finally, more than anyone else, Perry has made the data he uses available for all who will use it.

It has been and is COMMUNICATOR policy to publish material from any source which we feel will assist people to achieve the goals of psychotherapy and dianetics. We will be happy to consider any manuscripts up to 75 single spaced typewritten pages which are submitted to us.
