If you don't like the idea of pushing your own buttons, consider a more theoretically applicable item appearing under the dubiously derived title, Science Marches On. 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### EVALUATION OF E-THERAPY by Don Rogers, Director of Research

E-therapy is a technique devised by Mr. A. L. Kitselman of Honolulu. It is developed from a basic reference framework of dianetic procedure and would be considered an experimental dianetic technique except that it has been divorced from and promulgated independently of dianetics by Mr. Kitselman.

The basic principle of E-therapy is the installation by positive suggestion, of an examiner. This examiner is an all-wise and all-able entity in relation to his specific purpose, which is to run, reduce and erase engrams. The examiner is a special circuit created for a special purpose and although tremendously capable for that purpose, has no power or function apart from it. The examiner seems to be, in one sense at least, a demon circuit.

E-therapy seems to bear a strong contamination of previous philosophies and psychotherapies. The basic philosophy of

E-therapy outlines eight degrees of clearness, the first four of which are considered to relate to dianetics and to E-therapy. E-therapy further shows four phases, fire clearing, tremelo clearing, posture clearing and incident clearing. Moreover, according to the author, the stages of clearing discussed in E-therapy were established and taught by him prior to the formulation and publication of dianetics as a science. From this it may easily be seen that the use of the word "clearing" in this connection may not agree with the term as used in dianetics.

E-therapy seems to depend in part for its operation on the same function of the mind which is called into play in free-wheeling. This is the ability of the mind to contact engrams sequentially without the direct attention of an auditor. The application of this ability in E-therapy seems to be just as dangerous as in free-wheeling. That is to say it cannot be done on a general and promiscuous basis. It is particularly to be avoided in cases containing self-control engrams and large numbers of interfering phrases, because in these cases there is little practicality of channeling the activity to advance the case in any measurable degree, and there is also a great likelihood of jumping around from engram to engram and producing serious amounts of restimulation. This restimulation has been observed in a number of cases handled by either of these two techniques without proper safeguards. In one case E-therapy contributed the principle restimulation producing a psychotic break. The net risk is so great, and the net gain is so small, through the use of E-therapy on the average case by the average auditor that the Foundation does not recommend it.

Discoveries and development work in the Foundation at Elizabeth by C.C. Street and Elizabeth Byall culminated in the completion of processing on September 21, 1950 of the first case to be run by a new technique which is called chain-scanning. This technique is still experimental and is being used only on an experimental basis. The work accomplished with it is being watched with careful interest and concern, and release cannot be made to the general public until more data becomes available.

The technique of chain scanning is mentioned here because it does identify and use a portion of the mind which is sometimes used inadvertently in E-therapy and in free wheeling. It is also mentioned because a previous publication raised the question of whether credit should be due to Mr. Kitselman for inspiring Street and Byall to their work on chain scanning. That previous publication was based on an incorrect knowledge of the facts in the development. Information on E-therapy was not received in Elizabeth until late in September, 1950 on a September 27th date-line. At this time, a long period of work on chain scanning had already passed. Future reports and evaluations of chain scanning will be made separately.

#### Financial Report

Not long ago Mr. Jim Elliott took over the thankable but usually thankless job of Office Administrator. Papers flew, organization became the keynote and the business side of dianetics perked up its ears. We learned that dianetics, from the point of view that it has to pay for itself, must be run more business-like. Even considering ourselves as a big family affair we could not conceivably continue without a better knowledge of our assets and income and thereby know better how and how much we could spend. We needed to know what results were being obtained for our money, and each of our six departments had to be accounted for and recounted for in each of these respects.

Jim Elliott, fresh out of the Professional Course, was in a high tone X. and when interviewed the first day on the job, he bubbled out cheerfully with the good news that we would soon have a financial report. It would seem logical that this wouldn't be a difficult thing to prepare. It was.

Sure, figures about how many had taken the course, how many had intensified runs, how many Associate Members there were - these were available. But what were the actual figures on what was spent for psychometry, library and medical research, office equipment? What were the productive hours of auditors and employees and how many were wasted? What items bought should be written off over one

year, two years, five years and so on?

Mr. Quincy, controller of long and excellent standing with a number of major firms whose problems were very similar in substance to those which face dianetics, has now been acquired as a gilt-edged asset for dianetics. He has the troublesome task of assorting and arranging the various accounting facts and figures of all the dianetic Foundation, of determining what additional such information he needs and getting it, and then compiling all of this into budgets, result financial reports, and other reports necessary to get the mechanics of running dianetics into a practical, workable form.

When this is ready, the Dianamic will report it. Meanwhile we hope that Jim and Mr. Quincy receive our most cooperative efforts as we help them accomplish this vital task.

#### Internes Needed

Many of us have recently become interested in a group which is being developed by Edna Cushman, HDA of Bucks Co., Pa. Her efforts are directed toward establishing a combined general clinic and point of departure for newly certified HDAs whose plans for the immediate future are not specific or need time for development. Practice auditing, training of non-professional auditors, processing and living facilities are included in the program. Arrangements will be made for any auditor's pre-clears on a twenty-four hour basis, if necessary. The latter is especially important with regard to any pre-clear whose environment is restimulative to the point of interfering with processing, whether that pre-clear is an out-patient or HDA.

The long term plan of the organization is to staff and maintain a permanent clinic for the processing of pre-clears, further processing for auditors and a call-list of auditors available for emergency work with this group or for pre-clears contacted by this group who must be worked in another locality during a portion of their processing. This call-list will function on two levels:

- (1) Auditors who have time available for work with the group, spending specific days or hours at the clinic.
- (2) Auditors who would be interested in processing this group's pre-clears in another geographic location and/or sending to this group any pre-clears who need 24 hour attention but do not need hospitalization.

The group would appreciate hearing from any auditor interested in becoming associated with this type of organization. A post card addressed to Mrs. C. Laurence Cushman, Newtown R.D.1, Bucks Co., Pa., will establish the contact. Any auditor who is interested please state the how, when and where of his or her availability.

It should be understood that there is a great deal of work to be done. This work is of a voluntary nature and includes eating and sleeping necessities as well as the organization of the housing problems of the clinic. Auditors who have no family ties are especially welcome if prepared to work hard toward the stated goals. The immediate financial returns from the work with the group will be slim and based upon individual needs. There are several jobs available in this vicinity though they are not necessarily of a Dianetics nature. These jobs can be filled by auditors wishing to work with this group, but who must settle financial difficulties in order to do so.

The group has contacts with some influential and philanthropic people in Philadelphia and elsewhere. The immediate task is to present to these people an organization capable of realizing its goals and hence worthy of their support. A beginning has been made. More auditors are needed in order to accomplish this. Those who are already working with the group will welcome anyone who is sincerely interested in the established goals.

Trains and buses will be met if the group is advised of your arrival. The telephone number is Newtown 2517. Train connections into Langhorne connect with buses for Newtown at 8:30 and 12:20 A.M.

Trains will be met at either Langhorne or Trenton if bus connections for Newtown cannot be made. Come look the situation over for yourselves. The group welcomes you.

"Needless to say I put him back in reverie and ran the incident to somatic reduction and laughter tone."

It seems fitting at this time of year, to present a review of activity and interest on the OUTPOSTS OF DIANETICS.

Correspondence Department reports an ever increasing flow of mail from all parts of the world, with Associate Memberships getting a foothold of interest and activity in more areas of our own country, and in England, Scotland, Australia, Switzerland, France, Denmark, Puerto Rico, Bermuda, Sarawak, Pakistan, So. Africa, S. America, and Israel. A nucleus of expanding interest and study group activity is reported in the large cities of England and Canada.

MR. STONE, Coordinator of Group Activities says, "Work with Group Activities has been like the sowing of Winter Wheat. It has already sprouted shoots of growth in less than one month since first sowing the seed."

And, "Society on Official Levels," says JIM ELLIOTT, "Is now beginning to get down on the couch before condemning dianetics. Perhaps the day is here when the Blueprint of the Mass Production of Bridges has arrived."

HDA's are now going to other countries with their dianetic skills. They go equipped with concentrated information on organization of local study-groups, and they go prepared to educate enough pre-clears in dianetics so that they will be able to Carry the Ball by themselves.

BURKE BELKNAP, HDA, who came from Peru in July, has returned to Peru for a month's stay in order to train some auditors and get group activity organized there.

BOB WOODSON, HDA, is going after Christmas to Guatemala City to help BOB HOEGG, HDA of that city, get his dianetic practice established on firmer ground and get out from under a too-heavy load of auditing and classes.

ERIC FENNEL, HDA recently graduated, returning to Honolulu, tells the high points of dianetic activity there. The excellent Basic Course as given by Steve Lee swells the ranks of amateurs of Hawaii, who now use dianetic technique with admirable competence. A special feature, which has endeared the course to its members, is the six month's advisory service offered to them free of charge. (This has not been abused and has been much appreciated.) Then there is a special research project they are doing on Action-Phrases in Oriental

languages. This arises from semantic problems uncovered in auditing Chinese speaking pre-clears. The command value of some oriental phrases is simply amazing. Eric promises to report some of the most interesting of these.

In light of the interest of All of Us to know what Some of Us are doing on the OUTPOSTS OF DIANETICS, we are planning to make a special column with this sort of information beginning with the next issue.

So don't neglect to tell us, HDA's any news of dianetic activity in foreign countries, and new activity with dianetics anywhere. Via the DIANAMIC, we shall all be looking forward to your reports.

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#### FOUNDATION NEWS ROUND-UP

##### California

L. Ron Hubbard, as of December 12, began and is now giving a series of fifteen minute transcribed lectures over 126 radio stations. On the West Coast they are broadcast daily, Monday through Friday, at 10:15 a.m., but since the lectures are recorded on phonograph discs, they can be broadcast at whatever time is most convenient for your local station.

The lectures are distributed to radio stations by Progressive Broadcasting Co. They are broadcast during unsponsored time until the station obtains a sponsor for the program after which it is given a better period.

It is suggested that all you HDA's and your friends who are dianeticists call your local stations and ask if they are broadcasting the lectures and at what time. If you can aid the station in finding a sponsor, the lectures will reach a larger audience.

The station may give your group a "plug" or announce such dianetic news as the formation of a Hubbard Dianetic Study Group in your region, etc. You, in turn, can give the broadcast and the station publicity in your announcements and meetings.

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We hear from Ron, who has at last bought himself a new car and is enjoying pleasure cruises in this buggy that "can take corners at 55 or 60 without batting a tread." He reports some interesting information about getting a constitution put together for all of the Foundations.

"It includes a Bill of Rights for Staff members and a full modus operandi for conducting the business of the Foundation. The effort here is to answer up to the need for group action with tools to make the action possible.

"This constitution is being written and a copy of it is being distributed to each of the Foundations for the interest of the personnel. They can put it into operation, find out how it works, and within about 60 days they should know quite a bit about it. It is planned that at the end of 60 days that an elected member from each of the three major Foundations, at least, meet some place in the U.S., hold a constitution convention, and create a final draft of the constitution of the Foundation.

"This is obviously very, very necessary. The Foundations are trying desperately to match up with all the tenets of becoming a group and confusion or turmoil has resulted from not having the idea of true group in mind, in this attempt.

"Actually Administration, Board of Trustees, Staff Association and so forth are all trying to do the same thing, but it has to be done not only with the consent and knowledge of the staffs, it has to be done from the stand point of initiation from the staffs themselves. They have to have quite a bit to say in regard as to what goes on in the Foundation, and with that we can expect general operational efficiency to increase enormously."

##### Elizabethan Circle

Most important news, perhaps, is that the Foundation is scheduled for a change of quarters on the 10th of January. The town will remain the same, but the building will be different, and so, we hear, will be the accommodations. We're not sure if everybody's smiles are in anticipation of the move or of the Christmas weekend or both, and we couldn't care less.

\*Anyway, till the men in the white coats come and take your pre-clear away from you---or until Hubbard throws you into birth and leaves you there.

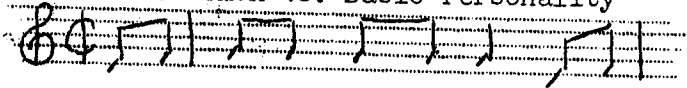
