The Narconon Technical Line-Up The Bridge To Total Freedom

1. "The Bridge To Total Freedom" chart is the religious progress chart of the Church of Scientology, showing a person's progress "up the bridge" toward total freedom offered by the upper levels.
2. "The Narconon Technical Line-Up" chart shows how one progresses through the programs and activities of a Narconon unit.
3. Compare the items of one with the other. Note that Detoxification/Withdrawal and the following Drug Education/Orientation Lecture are the only items on the Narconon chart that are not on the Bridge chart. We have been told that the detoxification method is pretty standard "cold turkey" withdrawal with which we have no complaint.
4. Note that the Hard TRs (0-9) Course, the Purification Program, Objectives, The Drug Rundown, and The Way to Happiness Rundown are all basic steps taken when one starts up the bridge of Scientology.
5. Note that most of these programs or courses require the services of an "Auditor". An Auditor, as we understand it, is a counselor who uses an E-Meter. An E-Meter operator is a minister in the Church of Scientology.

THE WAY TO HAPPINESS RUNDOWN

Counselling which can help put one on THE WAY TO HAPPINESS.
Prerequisite: Purification Program, Objectives, as directed by the Case Supervisor.

REPAIR ACTION

Confessionals, handling of life rudiments, GF 40 XRE, and handling of criminal tendencies. Such case actions to be determined by the Case Supervisor.

THE DRUG RUNDOWN

A series of counselling actions that can release an individual from the harmful effects of drugs, medicine or alcohol.
Prerequisites: Purification Program and Objectives. Any needed repair complete.

REPAIR ACTION

The person receives any needed repair per CIS Series 100R, Conditional Step Following the Purification Program and Objectives.

OBJECTIVES

A series of processes that can help bring the person out of past incidents and into Present Time with the ability to control and put order into the environment. The Objectives are delivered in two major parts:

1. They may be done concurrently with the Purification Program (as per CIS adjudication).
2. They are done (if not completed while on the Purification Program) in their entirety after the Purification Program so as to get the full End Phenomena of the Objectives.

Objectives Program Includes a Narconon CIS-1.
Prerequisite: Purification Program

PURIFICATION PROGRAM

A program which is designed to clean out and purify one's system and free the individual from the restimulative effects of drug residuals and other toxins.
Prerequisites: Medical okay to do the Purification Program. Hard TRs (0-9) is required of anyone who has recently come off of drugs.

HARD TRs (0-9) COURSE

Assists the person to come off drugs on his own volition and improves his ability to confront.

Gives the student an understanding of the basics of communication and teaches him to apply these basics so that he can communicate with others effectively.

Prerequisite: Drug Education/Orientation Lecture

DRUG EDUCATION/ORIENTATION LECTURE

Lecture designed to enlighten one as to what drugs are and how they affect the body, mind and you. Provides full orientation to the Narconon Program.

Prerequisites: None

DETOXIFICATION/WITHDRAWAL

A series of actions which are designed to alleviate the painful and mental withdrawal symptoms that occur when one is coming off drugs.

Prerequisites: Medical examination (preferably a full medical exam) and written okay to do the program by an MD.

(If person is currently not physically addicted to drugs.)
